



Media Rules and Requirements

1. In exchange for media access, all media are required to provide ClubLoose with a link to the location hosting their photos or videos after the event. A form will be sent out which must be completed before another media pass will be issued. ClubLoose may use these images or videos to promote events on social media. ClubLoose will provide credit to the content creator.
2. All media are required to wear long pants, closed toe shoes, shirts which cover the shoulders, and high visibility vests at all times on track.
3. Driver's meetings are mandatory for all media. If you do not attend the driver's meeting without making prior arrangements, you will not be allowed on track. Special media instructions may be announced after the drivers meeting.
4. When on track all media personnel must be in the areas designated for media. These locations are subject to change per track layout. If you do not know if you can stand somewhere ask a ClubLoose staff member.
 - a. For areas behind fences:
 - i. Limbs and equipment must not be extended past the plane of the fence.
 - ii. No new opening in fencing may be created.
5. Crossing the track is allowed only when the track is cold. The track is cold only when changing run groups or course workers are cleaning track or removing a stuck/broken car. Any media personnel found crossing the track during a hot lap session will forfeit their media credentials for the rest of the event. In the event of an emergency a ClubLoose staff member must be notified and will assist with crossing the track.
6. Ride Along Info:
 - a. For ClubLoose NJ: Media personnel are allowed to ride in Group A and B cars that have an approved passenger seat and harness set up in accordance with the [ClubLoose 2020 Rule Book - Rev H](#). Passengers are required to have their helmets meeting Drivers Requirements inspected.
 - b. For all other ClubLoose Locations: Media must follow with passenger rules laid out in the [ClubLoose 2020 Rule Book Rev H](#).
 - c. Media personnel must keep their equipment and limbs inside the vehicle when on the track.
7. ClubLoose maintains a zero alcohol policy for all media personnel who will be on track.
8. Failure to follow Club Loose rules or any instruction from racetrack staff will result in immediate ejection from the event and, depending on severity of offence, cause you to be banned from all future Club Loose events at all tracks. And we'll make fun of you as we walk you out. Think tar and feather...
